
HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 278

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 278 will hold a regular meeting on Thursday, February 12, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2400, San Bernard Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Public comments.
3. District website matters and related proposals.
4. Engineering report, including:
 - a. design, plan approval, advertisement for bids, contract award, approval of pay estimates and change orders, materials and field testing, permitting, storm water quality management plans, storm water pollution prevention plans, and other necessary actions relating to facilities, including:
 - i. wastewater treatment plant expansion;
 - ii. construction of new ground storage tank at water plant no. 2, including consider paint color options;
 - iii. rehabilitation of existing ground storage tank at water plant no. 2;
 - iv. wastewater treatment plant expansion, phase 2; and
 - v. generators for lift stations;
 - b. update on bond application no. 12;
 - c. approve Resolutions Expressing Intent to Reimburse, if appropriate;
 - d. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment and requests for service, utility commitment letters and/or annexation;
 - e. commercial development, including:
 - i. Creekstone at Tour 18 apartments;
 - ii. Atascocita Apartment project (11919 Will Clayton Parkway);
 - iii. Providence Church Atascocita on Timber Forest Drive;
 - iv. Alliance Prose Atascocita apartment project;
 - v. Waste Management Campus;
 - vi. Atascocita Road Warehouses;
 - vii. Medical Office and Retail (12227 Will Clayton Parkway); and
 - viii. Humble Indoor Sports Club;
 - f. "orphan channel" along Williams Gully, including maintenance and rehabilitation; and
 - g. annexation matters.

 - e. Participation Agreement with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality in connection with the Enforcement Diversion Program; and
 - f. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
6. Report on maintenance of District facilities and storm water quality permits, including proposals for work.
7. Garbage collection matters, including notice of consumer price index rate change and consider amending Rate Order.
8. Review action list.
9. Additional reports from directors and/or consultants and discuss future agenda items.
